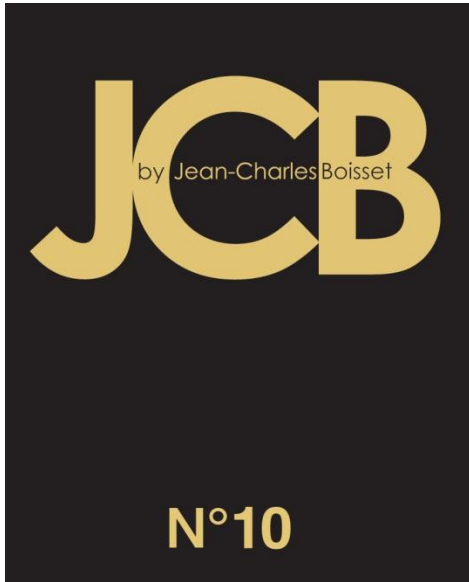

Winemaking Notes:

The unexpected rise in temperatures in August and September of 2010 was a mixed blessing. Due to cooler weather throughout the early part of the year, the heat spike was helpful in ripening the grapes to their ideal sugar and acid levels, but it also caused a shorter than usual window of opportunity for harvesting. This Cabernet Sauvignon was picked from some of the premier vineyards in the Napa Valley in the middle part of October, 2010.

- Aged in 100% French oak for 20 months; 45% new oak
- 273 cases produced

Tasting Notes:

- Color: Deep rich purple
- Flavor Profile: This powerful and intense Cabernet Sauvignon features concentrated flavors of Black Cherry and blackberry intermingled with notes of dark chocolate, licorice, espresso and spice.
- Food Pairing: Wild Boar with Boysenberry Compote
