Winemaking Notes:

After an unusual and volatile growing season, the grapes for this Cabernet Franc were hand harvested on October 1, 2010. The growing season was relatively cool, with a few heat spikes thrown in during the late summer months. The unseasonable temperatures helped contribute to a wine with concentrated flavors and elegant structure.

- Aged in 100% French oak for 20 months; 45% new oak
 - 45 cases produced

Tasting Notes:

- Color: Bright ruby red
- Flavor Profile: A mingling of rich red fruit flavors, cocoa powder, toffee, dark plum and licorice with smooth tannins and a long, lingering finish.
