Beautifully floral nose with light hints of honey and melon. Explosive effervescence on the palate, nicely balanced without an overwhelming sweetness. Tangerine, more honey and lots of melon fruits. This is a very fun wine, a party in a bottle. And perfect for sunny days and pool parties with low 5% alcohol. One bottle will not be enough.

Tantalizing aromas of white roses, gardenias, and dried lavender, the acidity of this wine is utterly refreshing and it's elegant in weight. The palate is further graced by hints of nectarine, snap peas, volcanic mineral, and an ambiance of Santorini's salty air.

There's something for the dinner table, something for the poolside lounge chair, and every picnic in between. Just don't forget to bring your corkscrew.

Vougeot Clos du Prieure

BURGUNDY, FRANCE • \$47.99

Elegant with a bit of muscle, this Burgundy exhibits fresh red cherry, mushroom, paprika, and saffron. Light powdery tannins are beefed up with smoky, savory, and dusty wood characteristics. Another brilliant wine from the Boisset Family.
