



**Lockwood Vineyard Chardonnay 2008 (\$12)**

**Lockwood continues to make a very reasonably priced chardonnay with pineapple and peach notes and a healthy dose of toasty oak.**

**WillaKenzie Estate Pinot Gris 2008 (\$20)**

From Oregon's Willamette Valley, this delightful pinot gris boasts generous pear/citrus aromas and exotic pineapple/kiwi flavors. Soft in the mouth and long in the finish.

**Albrecht Reserve Pinot Blanc 2008 (\$16)**

This wine offers a refreshing and fruity character that makes Alsace vastly underrated. This unoaked reserve has copious, soft pit fruit flavors and excellent balance. A good match to the traditional turkey dinner.

**Albrecht Reserve Riesling 2008 (\$19)**

We love the mineral, petro flavors of Alsace riesling because they are so unique. This version has floral aromas, and delicious apple and tropical fruit flavors, long finish.
