CK Mondavi and Family Introduces the Fourth Generation

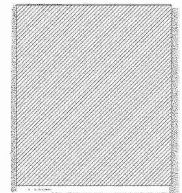

What do wineries in Napa, San Luis Obispo, and Spain's Priorat region have in common - aside from shared ownership? Answer: more than meets the eye. When Robin and Michelle Baggett added Perinet to their current portfolio of San Luis Obispo's Tolosa and Rutherford's Alpha Omega, they created a cohesive and complementary triangle of sister properties that produce world class wines.
