As 2018 starts to take off, it's clear we should expect the unexpected — from a blingy taxidermied deer to leather made without using cows.

**JCB brew** It's hard for Jean-Charles Boisset to contain his energy or ideas, so he doesn't. In addition to his nearly two dozen wineries in France, California, Canada and England; a JCB Tasting Lounge at the Ritz Carlton in S.F.; and his JCB brand of jewelry, accessories and candles sold online, he's dipping a croissant into the coffee business with First Growth Napa Valley Grand Cru Coffee. The signature blend, 60 percent Guatemala Antigua Finca Panorama and 40 percent Sumatra Gayo Longberry, is roasted locally. Beans are sold in 6.9-ounce bags for \$16 at his Atelier Fine Foods & Catering, 6505 Washington St., Yountville, and [www.atelierfinefoods.com](http://www.atelierfinefoods.com). A membership club is set to launch in the spring.
