



15 best new beers, gins, whiskies and wines in India right now

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There's been a slew of new tipples in the market. Our bars are looking fuller than they have in a long time. Whisky, craft beer, gin, wine... it's hard to keep track, what with all the hangovers coming in the way. But don't worry we've got you covered. Here are 15 of the top new bottles to put on your to-drink list.

13. J'NOON Wines



A collaboration between French vintner Jean-Charles Boisset and Fratelli wines has led to the J'NOON range of premium Indian wines. Made in Akluj at the Fratelli winery, with grapes from the region, the range comprises three labels – the sparkling JCB No. 47, J'NOON White & J'NOON Red – each limited to 2400 bottles only. Named in honour of the year of India's independence, the single-vineyard sparkling wine made of Chardonnay has a lovely complexity to it due to its ageing in barrels, but also prominent mineral notes along with tropical fruits which add freshness. The still white wine is a blend of Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc, while the red is made primarily of Cabernet Sauvignon grapes with additions of Petit Verdot, Marcellan and Sangiovese.
