Jean-Charles Boisset, also known as the James Bond of the wine world, is the charming French vintner and proprietor of the Boisset Collection.

Born in a vineyard, tasting his first wine at seven (he would eventually name a wine under his JCB label 'No. 7' as a tribute) and now the owner of a number of vineyards, Boisset knows how to enjoy life — "even if it's just eating a tomato sandwich on a wall," he tells us.

What does luxury mean to you?

My idea of luxury is to understand simplicity. I like to be able to evolve in all extremes comfortably yet allow the most important things in life to remain important. It's about being able

to enjoy the simple things.

What has been the most luxurious experience you've had?

I experienced a 'Secret Indulgence' in Napa Valley earlier this year. It includes 11 environments in two hours. It's a progressive dinner and experience, playing with all the elements in the world — like caviar on quail eggs — in unusual combinations. It is priced typically at \$1,000 per couple. It's not just the price but the whole idea that makes it a luxury.

Which destination do you recommend for luxury travel?

India – I have had an experience of a lifetime here. The sense of spirituality and relaxation is inspiring. It awakens and enlightens all your senses.

What are some wardrobe pieces every man should own?

Good shoes, cufflinks, scarves, jewellery and some nice jackets. You should have a signature style. I wear very unique shoes and red or purple socks.

What would you consider your most prized possession?

A most prized possession is what I don't possess yet. But, what I love the most in my wardrobe is my watch collection. My favourites are Patek Philippe, Audemars Piguet, Chopard and Cartier.

What other brands do you enjoy wearing?

When it comes to shoes, I always use the man with the red sole — Christian Louboutin. I like to wear Scottish yarn socks with my initials. I make my own shirts in Paris with Egyptian cotton. I adore scarves too — the brand is irrelevant. It's more about the style and colours. I like wearing Alexander McQueen suits.

St Laurent and Tom Ford come in close. And I used to love Gucci quite a bit, but I like the style of Dolce & Gabbana.

What is one thing you don't mind splurging on?
