

The wine of the week: the Rhone, accessible and affordable

To help you start the year smoothly, Nadia Fournier recommends, throughout the month of January, her favorites to less than 15 dollars.

The vineyard of the Rhone Valley is divided into two distinct zones: the south and the north. The southern Rhône, with its warm climate and constant mistral wind, is the source of 90% of the region's wine production. It is a fertile garden where Grenache Noir and a host of other grapes flourish under the sun, surrounded by scrubland and olive groves.

It is this sunny and warm expression found in this Ventoux wine, composed of Grenache and Syrah. Chubby and greedy, supple but not lacking in substance, with good tastes of black olives, cherries and herbs. Another very good weeknight wine.
