

DeLoach Vineyards' Le Royal sparkling wine - Product Launch

DeLoach Vineyards, based in California's Russian River Valley, has released its first sparkling wine, Le Royal, sourced from the Charles Heintz Vineyard in Green Valley.

The wine is a 2015 vintage blanc de noirs made from 100% Pinot Noir grapes and using the traditional method of a secondary fermentation in bottle. It was aged sur lie and en tirage for 24 months, then bottled in April this year before undergoing secondary fermentation and being disgorged on 15 May.



It is described as "bright, fresh and vibrant", with aromas of peach, peony and freesia and notes of strawberry and raspberry on the palate.

Jean-Charles Boisset, proprietor of DeLoach owner Boisset Collection, said the launch of Le Royal was "a dream come true", adding: "We were inspired to create Le Royal to reflect our passion for our French heritage and our exuberance for the terroir of the historic Heintz vineyard."
