January slip on the pole is no exception, here are many goodies, both news and new vintages from established manufacturers. Here's what to do to be fast, because these wines will fly out of the shelves tomorrow morning.

De Loach has over three decades made wine in the Russian River Valley, California. The property is certified biodynamically and has been run by the well-known Boisset family since 2003, which has many projects throughout the wine world.

De Loach Russian River Chardonnay 2015, California , USA, kr. 239.90 VP 4500301 (bu)

Light butter egg with tones of yellow baked apples and citrus. Good follow-up in the mouth with warm citrus * and roasted nuts, nice fruit concentration with hints of spider marmalade and melon. Rich dishes of fish, main poultry or pork tenderloin. **De Loach Russian River Pinot Noir 2015 , California, USA, kr. 269.90 VP 6977501 (bu)**

Some red berries and a streif of earth tones, sour fruit in the mouth. Good fruit concentration against strawberries and hints of pepper. Long juicy aftertaste with good texture. Slender dishes of game, veal or soup risotto.
