THE INK HOUSE Speakeasy Cellar Package

With a history dating back to 1885, the former Helios Ranch underwent a five-year restoration and opened as The Ink House in 2018. Located on St Helena Highway in the Napa Valley, the four-room inn combines Italian elegance, wine country style, and gracious hospitality. As part of a guest's two-night stay, they are invited to take part in the inn's new Speakeasy Cellar Package experience in the property's historic wine cellar. Guests will enjoy a completely private and customized wine tasting experience (from the Boisset and Gallo collections of wines, many not available to the public) in true luxury speakeasy-style surrounded by an exclusive library of bottles and high-end designer lounge furniture. Two nights, plus tasting begins at \$1,550 per couple.
