

Bill Zacharkiw: Why I don't make a note of every aroma and flavour

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This week's tasting notes: Four reds to try

Chorey lès Beaune 2014, Les Beaumonts, Jean-Claude Boisset, France red, <u>SAQ # 12987367</u>. Quite linear, so less fleshy than the last vintage. The fruit leans toward the darker side, and with very fine but multi-layered tannins. The finish goes to exotic spice, with clove and dried coriander that might be barrel, might be terroir — not sure — but the oak isn't overly noticeable. **Grape variety:** pinot noir. **Residual sugar:** n/a. **Serve at:** 16 C. **Drink now-2022. Food pairing idea:** apéritif, pan-fried salmon with coriander.
