JCB by Jean-Charle Boisset, Yountville

Must try: No. 69 (\$25)

"Flamboyant, vibrant and sensual" is how JCB describes one of their flagship sparklers, No. 69. Named after the year that creator Jean-Charles Boisset was born (1969), this wine, produced in Burgundy, is an elegant, easy to drink rosé made from 100% pinot noir.
