

JCB Salon Prive Opens in What Was Once the Gym

The Yountville space known for many years by locals simply as "the gym" has now opened as JCB Salon Prive, a part of the Boisset Collection.

Sweating is out at the former home of Yountville Health

and Fitness, and reflecting and dreaming is in in this private salon that focuses on guided tasting experiences of JCB's most exclusive wines.

"The salon is decorated in shades of white that represent

neutrality, purity and peace that serve as a canvas for the guests' imagination," explained Patrick Egan, Marketing and Communications Director for Boisset Collection.

Egan. The new enterprise is the third to be opened by Jean Charles Boisset in what is now known as JCB Village, formerly The Village and before that The Whistlestop Center.

Tastings are by appointment based on availability from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily with a featured \$65 Collector flight that includes JCB Gala Champagne, JCB Pinot Noir and JCB Napa Valley No. 1 and No. 10 Cabernet Sauvignons and The Surrealist Napa Valley Red Wine.

The new business operates under a transfer of the use permit for Cornerstone Cellars, which operated a tasting room in the same space for several years. The salon's operation is consistent with all requirements of that original permit, said Town Planning Director Sandra Liston.
