Burgundy's house of Louis Bouillot was founded in 1877 by Jean Bouillot, a wine and spirit merchant who named the label in honor of his father. All harvesting and sorting of grapes is done by hand.

Louis Bouillot Perle de Vigne Brut

France, 750ml

A richly textured sparkling wine that could easily be mistaken for Champagnes at twice the price. Displaying apple and pear aromas and flavors, medium-body with a creamy yet dry, complex finish. A great value. Enjoy as an aperitif with chicken or seafood or on its own.

Louis Bouillot Perle d'Aurore Rosé

France, 750ml

A sophisticated Rosé made using the Champagne method from Pinot Noir grapes. Pale rose in color with a medium-body and fine bubbles. The bouquet and palate feature cherry and strawberry notes with a dry creamy finish. Superb with salmon, shrimp and lobster.
