The 2013 Bâtard-Montrachet Grand Cru has a very succinct and precise bouquet, the oak neatly integrated, elegant and understated in style but still quite penetrating. The palate is fresh and vibrant, lime and citrus fruit on the entry and the acidity nicely judged. There is a touch of peachiness towards the finish but it remains a very seductive Bâtard-Montrachet that should age with style. Tasted May 2016.	
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
