Grapes harvested in the commune of Nuits-Saint-Georges. Indigenous yeasts. 16 months on lees without racking, 50% new barrels. Unglued, very light filtration. 6000 bottles. Alc. 12.5% Sugar 1.4 g / l. In 58 stores.
