OTELIA'S SELECTION PINOT NOIR

The Buena Vista Vinicultural Society, formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy, to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards, has been restored as a collection of unique, small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking. The Vinicultural Society explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of Sonoma County.

The Vinicultural Society explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of California's North Coast. Named for Count Haraszthy's youngest daughter, Otelia's Selection Pinot Noir is sourced from some of the finest vineyards throughout the North Coast of California.

Sourced from vineyards throughout the North Coast, our 2011 Otelia's Selection Pinot Noir was harvest from October 12 through October 29th and aged for 14 months in 15% new French oak.

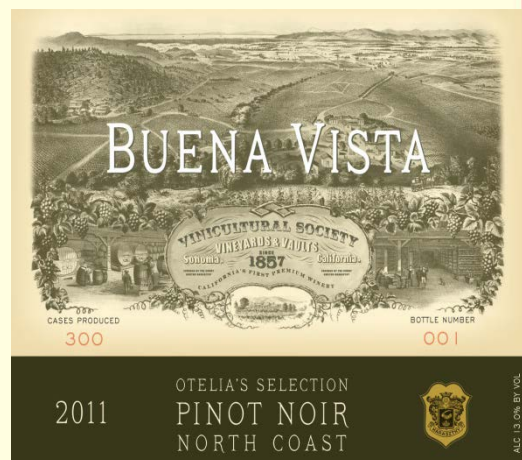
The 2011 Otelia's Selection Pinot Noir offers alluring aromas of cherry, and Mandarin orange peel. Bitter dark chocolate mingle seamlessly with a delicious brightness of Queen Anne's Cherry on the palate and is rounded out by a rich forest earthiness. This wine's balanced structure leads to a satisfying medium finish.
