In the Vineyard

At DeLoach Vineyards we strive to produce distinctive wines that highlight unique terroirs in a socially and environmentally responsible way, practicing sustainable viticulture and minimally intrusive winemaking. The fruit for this Pinot Noir was grown in a cool climate, allowing the grapes to ripen over an extended season to develop concentrated flavors. We selected fruit from some of the finest vineyards in the Russian River Valley, including the BCD, Starkey, Maboroshi, Pennacchio and Boriolo Vineyards.

Conversations with the Winemaker

After the grapes for this OFS Pinot Noir were hand-harvested and cluster sorted, we fermented them in small oak vats with native yeasts. The wine was gently basket-pressed and aged in 100% French oak barrels, which we hand-selected prior to blending, for 12 months prior to bottling.

Tasting Notes

The 2011 OFS Pinot Noir is a prime example of the quintessential Russian River Valley Pinot Noir from a colder growing season. The aromas and flavors of pomegranate, cranberry, rose petals and savory herbs are complimented by underlying minerality and sweet oak. With medium body, silky texture and complexity, this delicious wine will develop beautifully in the bottle.
