At DeLoach Vineyards we strive to produce distinctive wines that highlight unique terroirs in a socially and environmentally responsible way, practicing sustainable viticulture and minimally intrusive winemaking.

Our 2013 vintage is a blend from three world-renowned appellations. Monterey County grapes give our full bodied Le Roi Pinot Noir its dense fruit flavors, Sonoma County contributes to its luscious mouthfeel and texture, while Mendocino County adds the tannin structure and long, lingering finish.

ABOUT THE VINTAGE

The 2013 vintage across California was one of the earliest harvested vintages in years. A warm spring led to early bud break and created the perfect environment for flowering and fruit set. With warm days and cool nights, grape growers were able to maintain ideal acid levels with optimum, bright fruit flavors.

TASTING NOTES

The Le Roi Pinot Noir exudes rich flavors of black cherry, cranberry, shitake mushroom, and baker's chocolate. On the palate, this wine is full bodied with a silky mouthfeel and displays a long finish of black plum, baked pie and cinnamon toast. Pairs wonderfully with grilled lamb or a nice sheep's milk cheese.
