IN THE VINEYARD

Sourced and hand harvested from Saitone, Hill View and Slusser Vineyards, some of Russian River Valley's premier old vine Zinfandel vineyards, the fruit for this delicious wine was chosen for superior quality and variety. In warmer reaches of the valley where old vines persevere, grapes ripen over an extended season to develop wonderfully complex flavors.

CONVERSATIONS WITH THE WINEMAKER

Following careful cluster sorting, each pick is fermented separately with select yeast strains in both small open-top French oak vats and stainless steel tanks. The wine is gently pressed off and aged in barrels from a variety of forests and cooperages. During the 18 months aging in barrel, each barrel evolves differently. We select the most complimentary barrels from each vineyard to create our reserve blend - Our Finest Selection.

TASTING NOTES

Deep garnet in the glass, our 2013 OFS Zinfandel opens with aromas of blackberry pie and grilled peaches with a touch of rich caramel. Upon the palate, flavors of cherry and cocoa are accented with hints of vanilla. With firm tannins and medium plus body, this wine is ready to be enjoyed upon release but will also age beautifully. Pair the 2013 OFS Zinfandel with a grilled pork loin or braised vegetables.
