Inspired by Chateauneuf-du-Pape, this
Grenache-Syrah-Mourvedre based blend is an elegant balance
of deep, rich notes with acidity and bright top notes. Deep garnet
in color, you are greeted with dried mulberries, plum and mossy
bark on the nose. In the glass, potpourrie and spice notes open
up to notes of blackberry, currant, dried cranberry and a hint of
cacao nib. The palate is lively, plush, and textural leading to a
long, lingering finish.

Serve with Turkey stuffed with apples and sage or Veal Medallions with Truffle Jus.
