In the Vineyard


At DeLoach Vineyards we strive to produce distinctive wines that spotlight unique *terroirs* in a socially and environmentally responsible way. We practice sustainable viticulture and utilize minimally intrusive winemaking techniques that lets the *terroir* shine through in each wine we craft.

Conversations with the Winemaker

Our 2017 California Zinfandel was made from carefully selected Zinfandel grapes grown in prestigious, sustainably farmed vineyards across California. Select lots of old and new vine Zinfandel were blended to develop a complex, fruit-forward wine before being aged in primarily stainless steel tanks. A small portion of the wine was aged in seasoned oak barrels to impart a light oak characteristic while allowing the wine to stay true to its varietal character.

Tasting Notes

All of our California appellation wines carry the Heritage Reserve designation and reflect our commitment to showcasing the Golden State's sun-drenched *terroir*. Our 2017 California Zinfandel opens with spicy aromas mixed with red fruit notes. Layered flavors of tart cherry, raspberry and currant spread across the palate with touches of spice and white pepper. Bright acidity and well-balanced structure make this a perfect pairing to wood fired pizza or traditional barbeque.
