



NAPA VALLEY CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2017

In 1897, Frederick Durant and Willis and Joseph Booth moved into the Victorian home located next to the Mercantile & General Store that was founded in 1877 at the Oakville Crossroads. They transformed the destination into a grocery store for the Napa Valley.

Today, the historic family home stands at the gateway of one of the unsurpassed wine regions of the world and the home is now one of the finest homes from the era.

WINEMAKER NOTES Harvested in the cool morning hours from vineyards across Napa Valley including the Calistoga, St. Helena and Rutherford appellations, the grapes were hand sorted and underwent extended maceration before aging for 20 months in 30% new French oak.

This is a structured and elegant Cabernet Sauvignon with great depth and terroir. Red fruit aromas of strawberry and cherry spring from the glass and continue through to the palate. Raspberry and blueberry flavors mingle with dark chocolate notes and are layered with a touch of spice. The wine is textured and has an incredible, long-lasting finish.
