TASTING NOTES

This Pinot Noir comes from a handful of sites on the Sonoma Coast and was brought up in 15% new French oak. Ruby-purple in color, the perfumed nose jumps from the glass with notes of ripe dark cherry, red plum, fresh wild blackberries, and clove. Elegant texture on the palate with flavors of crushed fresh wild blackberries. Bina cherries. dried flowers and flagrant earth. Overall. this complex wine is medium bodied and youthful, with grippy tannins.
