IN THE VINEYARD

Harvest of the 2019 vintage occurred between October 12th and 16th. The Petit Sirah grapes were picked from our estate vineyard in Rutherford with rich, dense soils that elevate the tannin and structure of the wine. The Petit Verdot grapes came from our estate vineyard in St. Helena. The elements of these two estate vineyards combine to reflect a wine rich in Napa Valley history and terroir.

CONVERSATIONS WITH THE WINEMAKER

Our Small Lot Collection Petite Sirah grapes are from our Biodynamic and organically grown Estate vineyard in Rutherford and from a vineyard in Oak Knoll which adds texture to the wine. The Petit Verdot is also from another grower within Rutherford and seamlessly blends the Petite Sirah together which adding balance to the tannins. The wine was aged for 20 months in 19% new Leroi French oak barrels before bottling unfiltered.

WINE PROFILE

Dark fruit aromas of Cardamom, black cherry and blackberry envelop you in to this sensuous fruit forward wine. Nicely structured with powerful flavors of boysenberry and blueberry, there is a touch of spice and espresso interlaced into the textured palate. Well-balanced with fine-grained tannins, This is a delightful wine with well-balanced, fine-grained tannins and a finish that is fearless and lasting.
