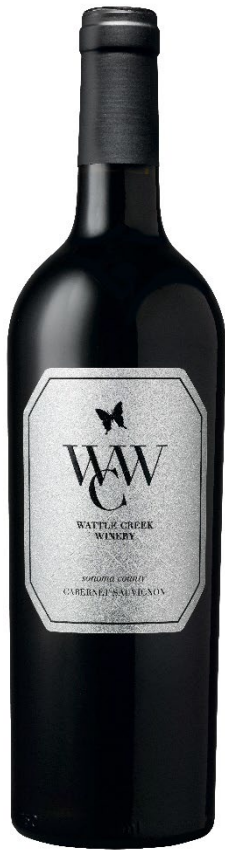




# 2020 Sonoma County Cabernet Sauvignon

## IN THE VINEYARD

Sonoma County is a diverse wine growing region with areas experiencing warm sunny days while other are affected by the cool morning fog from the bay. Vineyards for this Cabernet Sauvignon were selected based on their optimal climate and soil combination.

## ABOUT THE VINTAGE

2020 kicked off with ideal growing conditions. Mild temperatures led to evenly developed clusters and an early budbreak was followed by a warm to hot summer. Low winter rains resulted in smaller berries with concentrated flavors. Harvest started in early August and all things pointed to normal yields and exceptional fruit quality.

## TASTING NOTES

This 2020 Sonoma County Cabernet Sauvignon unveils an opulent, dark purple hue. It commences with splendid, opulent dark fruit aromas that captivate the senses. The palate is adorned with sumptuous flavors, enriched by a subtle infusion of nutmeg and dark molasses. This wine asserts its strength and audacity, showcasing structured flavors and intricate tannins. The finish is not merely an end but a seductive and mesmerizing conclusion to an enigmatic sensory journey.
