The Revenge Red Wine from Buena Vista Winery avenges Count Agoston Haraszthy's untimely death by a crocodile in Nicaragua in 1869. After leaving Buena Vista in 1868, the Count traveled south to pursue an ambition for sugar growing for rum production. Less than a year after arriving, the brilliant, yet flamboyant life of the Count ended abruptly when he fell from a tree branch while crossing a crocodile-infested stream.

The Count has returned to Buena Vista and adorned this bottle with a gilded crocodile to show the passion of the Count can never be struck down! Revenge is his!

## WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The Revenge is an unforgiving blend, bringing together Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc harvested from distinguished vineyards across the Napa Valley. From St. Helena, Diamond Mountain and Atlas Peak, the fruit was hand harvested and fermented with extended maceration. It was aged for 20 months in 100% French oak, 73% new, before being bottled unfiltered.

## TASTING NOTES

In a captivating ruby red hue, this wine entices with dark fruit aromas, showcasing black plum, blackberry, and a subtle hint of violet. The palate is adorned with bold flavors, where notes of espresso, toasted almond, black cherry, and a touch of black pepper generously coat the senses. Fine-grained tannins and well-balanced acidity pave the way for a prolonged and intense finish, leaving a lasting impression on the discerning palate.
