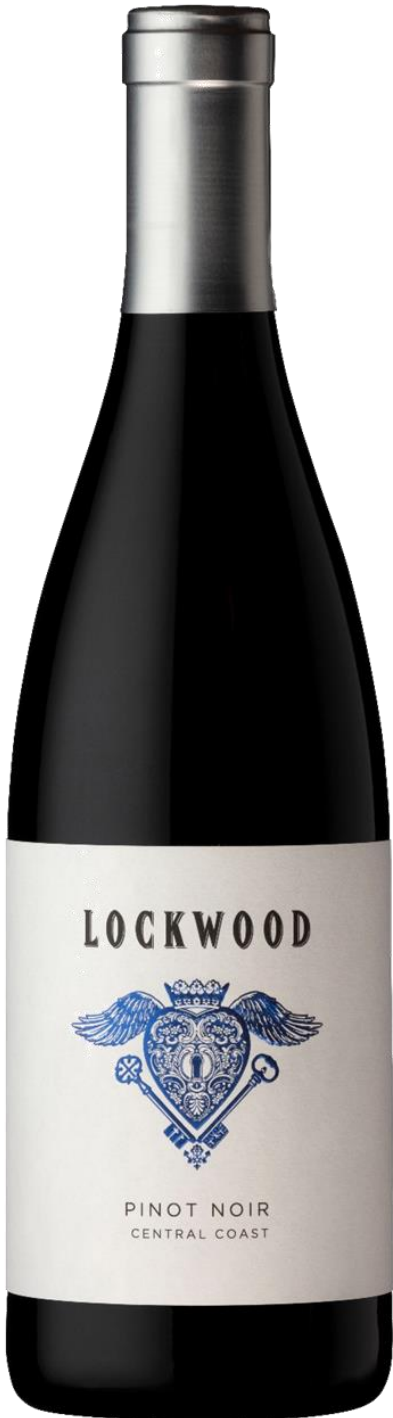

IN THE VINEYARDS

Grapes were carefully selected from fog-influenced vineyards across the expansive Central Coast, one of the most diverse and climatically cool grape growing regions in California.

ABOUT THE VINTAGE

2021 was a smooth and uneventful harvest season. June started out warm, followed by a cool and foggy July and August that slowed ripening and caused nice retention of acidity. Even ripening, with no extreme heat events, made for ideal growing conditions. Sparse winter rains resulted in an early budbreak, evenly developed clusters, and smaller berries packed full of flavor. Overall, the fruit was exceptional, making it another amazing year for quality.

WINEMAKER NOTES

This 2021 Pinot Noir unlocks the hidden side of the Central Coast with lively aromas of raspberry coulis, red plum, strawberry, and baking spices on the nose. Dried cranberry, Alpine strawberries, and sweet/tart cherries are showcased on the palate. This is a medium-bodied wine with outstanding texture and nuances of black tea on the long finish.
