The Buena Vista Vinicultural Society was formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy, to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards. The Vinicultural Society has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking. The collection of wines explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of Northern California.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Harvested on September 21, the grapes were sourced from the Ricioli vineyard, west of Fulton, in the Russian River Valley. The grapes were whole-cluster pressed with native fermentation and the lees were stirred occasionally to lend creaminess to the mid palate.

TASTING NOTES

Vibrant scents unfurl from the glass, a dance of tangerine, lime zest, and peach, accompanied by the sweet embrace of honeysuckle. This ethereal white wine, gracefully light-bodied, unveils a symphony of bright acidity and tart nuances. Green apple, grapefruit, and lemon take center stage, their crisp notes performing in harmony. The tasting experience deepens with hints of sweet melon and blanched almonds, crafting a nuanced profile that culminates in a refreshing and crisp finish, inviting one to savor the lingering echoes of this captivating composition.
