

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The start of the 2022 growing season was marked by favorable weather conditions extending into the early summer months. However, the situation shifted as a prolonged heatwave emerged in late August, hastening the harvesting process and leading to diminished yields for certain grape varieties.

TASTING NOTES

The 2021 Count's Selection Grenache extends a warm embrace, offering an aromatic journey of fresh raspberry, strawberry, and citrus notes that beckon from the glass. On the palate, it enchants with a symphony of flavors, showcasing the allure of red cherry, the warmth of cinnamon, and the delicate essence of anise, accentuated by a dusting of cocoa and a hint of white pepper. Luxurious, interwoven tannins elevate the experience, guiding towards an extravagantly lengthy and stimulating finish that captivates the senses.
