With its roots so deeply ensconced in the foundations of Sonoma where it was established in 1857, Buena Vista Winery is again introducing wines from Sonoma. The Sonoma wines include a diverse array of varietals that celebrate the diversity of Sonoma's terroir and the contribution of Buena Vista to establishing the California wine world.



Our 2014 Sonoma County Cabernet Sauvignon is comprised of grapes grown between 800ft and 2000 ft in elevation from some of Sonoma County's premier vineyards. The grapes were sourced from the renowned vineyards of Chiappellone from Rockpile, McCoy from the newly formed Fountaingrove AVA, and Bar None's Canyon, Amarao, Alta Vista and Ledson Terraces from Moon Mountain. Within these mountainous sites nature governs yields, and vines produce small amounts of intensely flavored fruit. Resulting wines are muscular, age worthy and characterized by dark fruit, flint and lively acidity.

86% Cabernet Sauvignon, this wine was blended with small amounts of Malbec (11%), Cabernet Franc (2%) and Petite Verdot (1%). The wine underwent extended maceration in the tank before being aged for 13 months in 100% French oak barrels, 10% new and was then fined and bottled unfiltered.

This rich, dense wine offers seductive aromas of black currant, plum and brambles with an opulent palate of black cherry, raspberry and a touch of soft spice. Great structure and plush tannins make this immediately enjoyable but also age worthy for the next 5-7 years.
