



2015 ATTILA'S ZINFANDEL SONOMA COUNTY

he Buena Vista Vinicultural Society, formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards, has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking. The Vinicultural Society explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of

Named for Count Haraszthy's son who managed Buena Vista Winery with his father, Attila's Selection Zinfandel was sourced from vineyards in the warmer

Northern California.



region of Sonoma Valley as well as in the Russian River where the days are warm and the nights are cool, the perfect growing conditions for Zinfandel – a varietal The Count helped make prominent in America. This big, bold wine was fermented in open top fermenters with hand punch downs before being aged for 18 months in French oak, 25% new oak.

A robust nose of plumb skin and blackberry with notes of toasted caramel jump out of the glass of our 2015 Attila's Selection Zinfandel. Lavish flavors of wild strawberry and blueberry mingle with notes of mocha and a hint of pepper spice. Coating upon the palate with chewy, juicy tannins and a lavish finish, this wine is immediately enjoyable, but also worthy of aging over the next 5-8 years.
