In keeping with the adventurous spirit of Buena Vista's founding, we are proud to bring you this delicious 2018 Cinsault Rosé, known for being lightly pink in color and beautifully fragrant with high acid and bright fruit flavors.



Harvested from prestigious vineyards in Sonoma Valley, this beautiful Rosé was picked at its peak of perfection. This delicate grape was aged in stainless steel to maintain its bright acidity and fresh flavor. From the glass, our 2018 Cinsault Rosé is bursting with aromas of wild strawberry and rose water. On the palate, alluring flavors of ripe cherry, juicy raspberry and a touch of orange peel lead to a crisp, well-balanced wine with high acidity and structure.
