



NATALIA'S SELECTION RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY CHARDONNAY

he Buena Vista Vinicultural Society, formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards, has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking.

The Vinicultural Society wines explore the incredible terroir of Sonoma County. Named for the wife of the Count's son Attila and the daughter of General Mariano Vallejo, Natalia's selection Chardonnay is harvested from



the Green Valley region of the Russian River Valley, where the warm summer days and cool nights of the region allowed the select blocks based upon optimum ripeness and flavor maturity. The grapes for our 2014 Chardonnay were harvested between October 3rd and 4th during the early morning to keep the fruit cold. The wine underwent 100% Malolactic fermentation and was aged in 100% French oak, 33% new, for 13 months prior to bottling.

Our 2014 Natalia's Selection Chardonnay opens with aromas of baked apple, Meyer lemon, and a touch of toasted coconut. A stunning golden color in the glass, this delightful medium bodied wine is accented by flavors of sweet apple, creamy vanilla, and light buttery oak. This enticing combination of flavors and fragrances creates a nicely balanced, smooth Chardonnay with a wonderfully lengthy finish.
