2013 SAUVIGNON BLANC

Founded in 1857 as California's First Premium Winery, Buena Vista Winery is delighted to share with you some great new varietals in its portfolio, including this North Coast Sauvignon Blanc.

This 2013 North Coast Sauvignon Blanc was harvested from some of the finest vineyards in the appellation. Picked between August 30th and September 9th, the fruit was fermented in stainless steel tanks to help preserve the varietal's natural freshness with occasional lees stirring to lend a creamy texture to the mid palate.

The 2013 vintage across the North Coast was one of the earliest harvested vintages in years. A warm spring lead to early bud break and created the perfect environment for flowering and fruit set. With warm days and cool nights, our grape growers were able to maintain ideal acid levels with optimum, bright fruit flavors.

This is a refreshingly clean Sauvignon Blanc perfect for those warm summer days. Its crisp acidity is equally balanced with good structure and showcases flavors of lemon, some grassiness and a touch of white pepper. It ends with a medium finish on the palate and would be a great match for many Thai and Asian inspired dishes.
