2014 SONOMA COUNTY CHARDONNAY

With its roots so deeply ensconced in the foundations of Sonoma where it was established in 1857, Buena Vista Winery is again introducing wines from Sonoma. The Sonoma wines include a diverse array of varietals that celebrate the diversity of Sonoma's terroir and the contribution of Buena Vista to establishing the California wine world.

The 2014 vintage in Sonoma County was one of the earliest harvested vintages in years. A warm spring led to early bud break and created the perfect environment for flowering



and fruit set. With warm days and cool nights, our team was able to maintain ideal acid levels with optimum, bright fruit flavors.

Our 2014 vintage of Sonoma County Chardonnay was harvested from our vineyard partners in various regions of the Sonoma County appellation to craft a wine that was immediately enjoyable upon release.

The 2014 Sonoma County Chardonnay opens with fresh, clean aromas of lemon peel and Granny Smith apples. Upon the palate, this medium bodied wine offers alluring flavors of almond paste balanced with citrus to present a medium plus acid and long finish.
