The inaugural release of the Chateau Buena Vista Cabernet Sauvignon celebrates and honors Buena Vista's indelible presence and significant contributions to the California wine world.

Inspired by the Count's influence on the foundation of Napa Valley, where he trained and inspired many young winemakers that would go on to found some of Napa's most acclaimed historical wineries, such as Charles Krug, Buena Vista has returned to Napa Valley, where Cabernet is the King, if not for the Count.

"Classic" and "perfect" are just two accolades being bestowed upon the 2012 Napa Valley growing season and harvest. Textbook conditions saw near-ideal spring bud break, steady flowering, even fruit set, and a lengthy stretch of warm days and cool nights during the long summer months. Late and light rains held off until Napa Valley's treasured wine grapes found optimal ripeness, bringing exceptional quality to the crush pad and into the cellar.

Our homage to the power and tradition of Buena Vista Winery, the 2012 Chateau Buena Vista Cabernet Sauvignon is a dense, rich wine that opens with enticing aromas of currants and cranberry with a hint of dusty spices and herbs. Upon the palate, concentrated flavors of blueberry, strawberry, mocha and caramel are balanced with a touch of incense. This full-bodied wine has fine grain tannins and a long, sumptuous finish to be enjoyed and savored.
