CABERNET SAUVIGNON MOUNT VEEDER

IN THE VINEYARD

The fruit for our Mount Veeder cabernet sauvignon came from an historic Napa Ranch, Brandlin with 180 degree views from St.Helena to the San Pablo Bay, Hillside, Clone 337.

WINEMAKING

The 2019 vintage was a near picture-perfect growing season that began with a warm temperatures to kick off the season and then mild temperatures for a slow development of the fruit. These mild temperatures created a long growing season and with an extended hangtime developing balanced acidity and beautiful complexity.

TASTING NOTES

Opaque dark crimson. The nose is immediately enticing, slightly spicy, with an engaging freshness of wild mint, ripe fig, purple plum, and fresh strawberry coulis. In the mouth, the fruit basket really reveals itself with juicy red and blue fruit flavors bursting on the tongue and coating the palate. The tannins are beautifully integrated and just beginning to resolve but hold the finish a little tighter, reminding you the wine is still very much in its youth.
