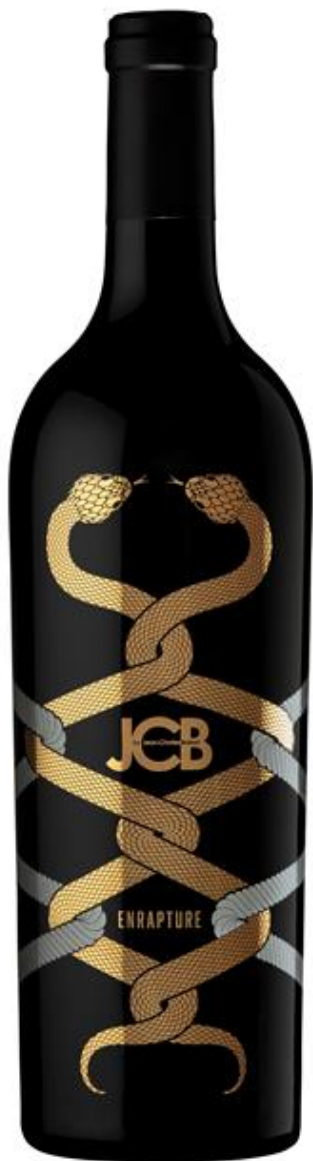

Napa Valley Red Wine

Grape Variety: Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc

Region: Napa Valley

Winemaking Notes:

- Aged in 100% French oak
- 46% new French oak
- 20 months
- 15.0% ALC
- 3.89 pH
- 5.9 TA

Tasting Notes: The 2019 Enrapture is a blend of four prestigious hillside Napa Valley vineyards, found in the Howell Mountain, Rutherford and St. Helena AVA's plus a splash of Oakville to round out the tannins.

A rich purple in the glass, this Cabernet led blend opens with dark fruit, violets and cassis aromas. The mouthfeel is round and soft with a flavor combination of red and black berries, striking spices and cocoa nibs emphasized by toasty oak. This elegant wine is full-bodied with medium-to-high tannins and palpable acidity.
