Region: Nine Napa Valley vineyards with the majority of grapes coming from Rutherford

Winemaking Notes:

- Aged in 100% French oak
- 17% new oak
- 25 months

Tasting Notes: A Cabernet Sauvignon based blend, the 2016 Snake comes from 9 vineyards across the Napa Valley. Sandalwood, Blackberry and Nutmeg greet you on the nose. The Rutherford dust dances across your palate, with notes of dark cherry, chocolate and hints of cedar, rose petal and black tea. Bright acidity on the front of the palate leads to restrained power and a long lingering finish.

Stunningly **SLEEK** and smooth, with elaborate flavor patterns like the skin of a snake, this bottle's **STRIKING** elixir has fangs that will provoke the serpent within you... charming its way into a **TRANSCENDENT** euphoria.
