

## Surrealist Brut Rose

Grape Variety: 48% Pinot Noir/52% Chardonnay

**Region:** Los Carneros

## **Winemaking Notes:**

Alcohol: 12%

- Bottled with 0.9% residual sugar

**Tasting Notes:** Napa Valley's southernmost region, Los Carneros, provides these exceptional chardonnay and pinot noir grapes which shine brightly and harmoniously.

In the glass, this wine is a shimmering pale salmon in color and delights the nose with strawberry, raspberry, orange zest, White flowers (jasmine) and a subtle minerality. On the palate, it's a journey from fruity juice notes of red berries and pineapple, followed by just a hint of yeast and finishing with a tart flavor burst.
