Tasting Notes: An unusual combination of varietals, the JCB Tiger brings together a unique balance of Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot and Malbec. Enticing on the nose with dark fruit aromas of blackberry and blueberries that mingle with baking spice and black currant. This wine delights with notes of cedar and mouthwatering flavors which dazzle the palate. Balanced acidity with a rich, yet velvety-smooth tannin structure, this wine will intrigue for years to come.

What Tiger Signifies: The Tiger is an uncommon Napa Valley blend with enticing energy and heart. The lush, velvety femininity of the Cabernet Sauvignon unites with the animalistic spice and power of Syrah and the graceful acidity of Malbec. It is rich and dense, while delicate and feminine... It is wild and harmonious!
