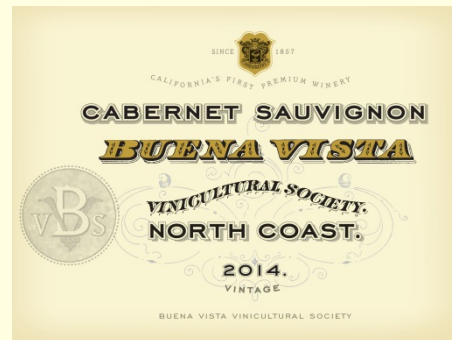

The North Coast wines include a diverse array of varietals that celebrate the diversity of California's terroir and the contribution of Buena Vista to establishing the California wine world.

This delightful Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from vineyards in the Fountaingrove District, Sonoma Mountain, and Alexander Valley – all part of California's distinctive North Coast appellation.

The 2014 vintage in Sonoma County was one of the earliest harvested vintages in years. A warm spring led to early bud break and created the perfect environment for flowering and fruit set. Moderate temperatures, with only minimal rain in September, allowed for even ripening and optimal fruit maturation.

The 2014 North Coast Cabernet Sauvignon opens with aromas of small, dark fruits and black cherry juice. Flavors of black currant and cherry are accented with a touch of black pepper. With medium body, velvety tannins and a plush mouth feel, our Cabernet Sauvignon is made to be enjoyed now and paired with hearty dishes.
