2014 PINOT NOIR NORTH COAST

ith its roots so deeply ensconced in the foundations of Sonoma where it was established in 1857, Buena Vista Winery is again introducing wines from the North Coast. These wines include a diverse array of varietals that celebrate the diversity of the North Coast's terroir and the contribution of Buena Vista to establishing the California wine world.

This enjoyable Pinot Noir is sourced from vineyards in Sonoma and Lake Counties, including vineyards in the Russian River Valley, Sonoma Coast, Sonoma Valley and Carneros – all part of California's distinctive North Coast appellation.



The 2014 vintage in Sonoma County was one of the earliest harvested vintages in years. A warm spring led to early bud break and created the perfect environment for flowering and fruit set. Moderate temperatures, with only minimal rain in September, allowed for even ripening and optimal fruit maturation. The grapes for this Pinot Noir were harvested between September and mid-October before being sorted, pressed and aged for 10 months in a blend of French, Hungarian and American oak barrels.

Enticing aromas of raspberry, cocoa powder, clove and cardamom open our 2014 North Coast Pinot Noir. Flavors of red fruits, cherry pie and hints of cinnamon softly spread across the palate. Lower acidity and bright fruit flavor make this a wine to be immediately enjoyed.
