JOB DESCRIPTION

Children's Minister Brentwood Baptist Church

SUMMARY

The part-time Children's Minister is responsible to the church, under the direction of the Discipleship & Connection minister, and is responsible for developing a comprehensive Biblically-based education program for children in grades K-5.

PRIMARY JOB RESPONSIBILITIES may include but are not limited to the following:

- Identify the needs of children grades K-5 and their families within the church family and larger community to which the church ministers
- Plan specific ministry activities and events to meet the needs of children and their families
- Ensure that all children's educational materials are Biblically-based and age-appropriate
- Supervise the work and overall direction of the Children's Ministry including Sunday morning programming,
 Sunday Night programming (in conjunction with adult life groups), New Christian Class
- Coordinate recruiting, vetting and training of all children's workers
- Serve as a counselor with children and families in matters of salvation, baptism and in matters of personal and family concerns
- Provide pastoral care for those serving in elementary ministries
- Oversee the Children's Ministry budget
- Plan and conduct leadership training for new teachers and volunteers and continued training for experienced leadership
- Give full support to our families and work with the Discipleship and Connections Minister to support and challenge
 our parents to be the primary disciplers of their children through resourcing, programming, intentional
 relationships, and having a deliberate strategy for getting parents directly involved in the ministry

OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES may include but are not limited to the following:

- Be available for counseling of church and nonchurch members as needs arise
- Collaborate with Preschool and Student Minister to develop a comprehensive plan for ministry to Birth-12th Grade
- Serve as a facilitator or leader in periodic workshop or class related to family and/or children's ministry
- Serve as a liaison to staff and church membership to communicate children's ministry needs
- Give planning and direction to special children's ministry events such as Vacation Bible School, camp and mission efforts
- Attend all required staff meetings and complete forms and reports in a timely and concise manner.
- Must have flexibility to accept and execute other duties as assigned



Support and coordinate the ministry work for children (K-5) with special needs and their families
