In order for them to be able to answer this call, they need our prayers and support. We want to give everyone an opportunity to support them in this work. Our VBS offering this year will go towards helping them set up and do ministry in NYC. We have set Sunday, July 23 as a day to take a special love offering for them. It is exciting to see someone grow up and respond to God's call to plant churches in an area that needs a Christian witness. Pray for them and support this couple as they serve and follow God.

Below is an update from Brenton and Danielle as they prepare for their move.

"for he has prepared a city for them." - Hebrews 11:16 (ESV)

Many times in the midst of uncertainty we look to Scripture for comfort. That's just what my wife, Danielle, did as she sat by the pool a few weeks ago. As plans turn into reality, the daunting task of moving from our quiet, country house in Jones County to the busy streets of Manhattan sometimes overwhelms us. This was one of those days for Danielle, but as she read the words of Hebrews she was convinced that, no matter our fear, God has already set a perfect plan into motion. Not only has He prepared a heavenly home for us one day, He has provided a city here on earth for our family to feel at home.

When God began to call us to NYC over two years ago, we were excited, but honestly we never thought it would happen. Now, just a few more than 100 days to go before our move to the big city, those distant dreams have become reality. Along with this reality has come much clarity in the plans God has for us, but also many questions that we had no idea we would have to answer 24 months ago. Where will we live? Who will our friends be? Where will we work and hang out? These are just a few of the questions that run through our minds daily. But while many questions go unanswered, God has provided many answers for which we are so thankful.

This journey has been a roller coaster, and we aren't even in the city yet. Beneath all the hustle and bustle of planning for a move and life in the city, God has given us clarity in our plans. If you will allow me just a few minutes, I would like to share some updates with you.

We knew from the beginning that God was calling us to help plant churches in the center-city of Manhattan. He has answered that promise. We are so excited to be partnering as ministry interns and team members with a new church in the West Village called Restoration Church. This church is led by a wonderful couple named Rob and Riley Russell. The Russells moved from New Orleans just over two years ago. Their passion for the West Village is contagious. We couldn't be more proud to walk alongside them to see God do miraculous works in the West Village. For over a year now, they have been working toward a launch date in September of 2017 for a week to week worship service. We will be joining them in November to assist in their calling to the West Village.

Church planting is hard in the city. To reach a post -Christian society, it takes much prayer and trust in the One who calls to succeed. That is why we are teaming with likeminded leaders to serve the city that we love so dearly. While we have long-term plans to plant churches all across Manhattan, we are excited to see this small group of believers in the West Village share the gospel with the nations right in the heart of NYC.

Joining this group of believers opens up many doors for Danielle and me. First, it allows us ground floor access to see the beginning stages of how a church plant works in the city, and we join a group of believers already established in the city. Secondly, it allows us access to a strong network of churches all over the country that has a passion for planting churches in urban areas from New Orleans to Denver to Orlando and NYC. Finally, it provides a runway for us to prepare and educate ourselves to prepare for our calling to plant a neighborhood church in NYC in the coming years.

While God has revealed some great things to us about his plan, we still have unanswered questions. We are still in the process of securing jobs and housing. We ask you to continue to pray for us as we seek God's guidance in these decisions. We know He is faithful and will provide.

Danielle and I would like to thank you for your continued support and prayers as we prepare to be a part of Gospel-centered restoration for the city of New York and its people.
