GREAT RECYCLING NEWS!

You can now put #1, #2, and #5 plastic tubs into your recycle cart! This includes many of those clear plastic containers from the grocery!

Despite some legal challenges, Oregon's new EPR policy went into effect in July 2025 to bring uniform recycling across the state and more materials collected.

The goal of the law is to modernize Oregon's recycling system, expand access — especially in rural areas — and ensure companies help cover the costs of recycling the materials they produce.

Companies that sell packaged products in Oregon are now financially responsible for helping the state collect and recycle that packaging!

What can go into your recycling cart:

PLASTIC TUBS (#1, #2, & #5 only), buckets, and rigid plant pots. Rinse first.

CARDBOARD includes food and beverage cartons, ice cream containers (No lids). Rinse first.

PLASTIC BOTTLES with screw top lids, leave the lids on! Rinse first.

METAL CANS Rinse first.

CARDBOARD & MIXED PAPER currently accepted in our program will continue to be accepted in our blue-lid recycling carts.

What cannot go into your recycling cart:

Aerosol cans and aluminum foil will move to depot-based collection (start date TBA for these items).

No bagged recyclables.

No batteries.

No foam.

No plastic bags/stretchy plastics.

No hoses, cords or wires.

This is an outstanding win for recycling across Oregon!

Saving Our Environment

The following can all be recycled: All items must be empty and dry.

Plastics: All items must be 2” by 2” or larger (Bottles, tubs, buckets, and rigid plant pots.) Caps on items is okay.

Metals: Aluminum and steel cans, and scrap metal. (Less than 10 pounds and 18 inches.)

Cardboard and Cartons: Flattened cardboard, packing boxes, & food and beverage boxes. Pizza boxes must be empty with no food residue.

Paper: Newspaper, magazines, office paper, paper egg cartons, mail, paperback books, paper bags, and non-metallic gift wrap.

NO!

No bagged recyclables

No batteries

No foam

No plastic bags or stretchy plastics

No hoses, cords, or wires
