

It's Laundry Day...again..... sigh.....

Part 1

Your laundry basket and everything that involves has a bigger impact on the planet than you might think.

Because it takes so much energy to heat the wash water and run the dry cycle, there's an opportunity for us to reduce our environmental footprint by decreasing the energy and water use. By looking carefully at what we put into the wash water and into the dryer tub can also contribute to this reduction.

Here are some points to ponder:

Wash clothes less often.

The simplest problem-solver is to launder less often. Clearly, undies and socks have to be washed after each use. But think of jeans, jackets and pullovers. You can easily wear them at least a couple of times before tossing them on the dirty pile.

Go Cold.

Going cold is good for the planet - and your wallet - since 90 percent of the energy the washing machine uses is to heat the water. Colder water also doesn't shrink clothes, it prevents color bleeding and helps your clothes last longer. Win-win-win for sustainable laundry!

Use the Quick Cycle on your wash machine.

Doing laundry with shorter cycles is another important step towards a more sustainable routine. A 30-minute cycle at 68°F is "significantly better" for your clothes than an 85-minute cycle at 104°F researchers have found out. Shorter and colder cycles also reduce microfibers from breaking apart - by 52 percent.

Quick wash cycles use less water and energy compared to their regular counterparts. They save all of us money and time! Wohoo!!

Clothes worn on a typical day, like jeans, t-shirts, and casual wear, are prime candidates for the quick wash. They're usually not heavily soiled and don't require a lengthy cleaning process. However, quick wash isn't the best choice for heavily soiled items, bedding and towels, and items with stains that need pre-treatment.
